

The spelling of the FREESTONE surname is variable. Not wanting to tinker with history in any way, and at the risk of appearing pedantic, I have used the spellings which are in the records rather than tidying things up by making names uniform. On this chart, for persons born in Woodton, I have used the spelling in the church register baptism record. For those born after 1837, I have used the GRO birth record spelling. In addition, where the GRO marriage record has a different spelling, I have added that afterwards in brackets.



Simon's parents were Simon MILLS, born in Cantley, Norfolk, and his wife Ann, born in Ludham, Norfolk, who was Ann [BENSLEY] according to a record in the IGI.

Simon MILLS sometimes gave his name as Simon SAUL. The GRO marriage registration for his first marriage to Emily FREESTONE is in the name Simon SAUL (1859). The 1861 and 1871 censuses give his whole family with surname SAUL. All other records for him and his family are in the name MILLS, including the church record of his marriage to Emily (according to the IGI).

After Emily died, Simon was remarried in 1879 to Ann [CLARK] HIGH of Postwick, Norfolk, whose first husband Charles HIGH had died in 1872 age 43.
