Sarah is recorded as "Chair woman" in the 1871 census.
This could be a mistake intended as "Charwoman", or
possibly a maker or mender of chairs.

In 1901 William MOORE is recorded as pauper at
Blything Union Bulcamp (or Bulchamp) Workhouse,
Blythburgh, Suffolk.

Honor had a natural child
Elizabeth NOBBS in 1829.

John was baptised son of John MOORE and Charlotte[ALGAR] in 1803 in
Hempnall. The 1802 Hempnall marriage record of this couple gives the
bride's name as Charlotte AUGER.
After his first wife, Honor [NOBBS] died, John MOORE was remarried in 1865 to
widow Elizabeth [MANTHORPE] ROBERTS, of Herringfleet, Suffolk. Elizabeth
had been with him as housekeeper in 1861. In 1881, John and Elizabeth, still in
Hempnall, are both recorded as "Pauper". After John died, Elizabeth went to live
with her son in Elswich, Northumberland, where she died in her eighties, in 1893.

The baptismal entry for Maria, and the civil
birth registration for Charles were in the name
MOOR (without the "e"). All other
birth/baptisms of these siblings had MOORE.

There are several families with surname MOORE producing in Hempnall around this time.
The following are baptisms of those who may be confused with the children of John & Honor:

1831 Sarah MOORE d. of John MOORE (thatcher) & Hannah [BARBER].
1832 Mary MOORE d. of John MOORE (thatcher) & Hannah [BARBER].
1833 Mary Ann MOORE illegitimate d. of Sarah MOORE (probably died in 1837).
1838 James MOORE s. of George MOORE (labourer) & Louisa.
1843 George MOORE s. of George MOORE (labourer) & Louisa.

Hannah's parents were John BROWN, a mariner, born in Weston near Beccles, Suffolk,
and his wife Mary [PAGE], born Brampton, Suffolk, married on 21 Dec 1856 in Beccles.

In the 1851 census, John BROWN, age 16, is recorded as a prisoner in Beccles.
Hannah's birth was registered as Hannah Elizabeth BROWN (4th qtr 1858 Wangford r-d).
The family moved to Lowestoft in 1860 after Hannah's sister Edith was born. Hannah
was baptised in Lowestoft on 7 Oct 1860, in the name Hannah Eliza BROWN, daughter
of John & Eliza BROWN (IGI).

Harriet was baptised Harriet CATLING, on 24 Sep 1822
(birth 19 Sep 1822), at Sandcroft (local name for St Cross
Southelmham, Suffolk), daughter of John CATLING and
his wife Mary (Southelmham St Cross registers fiche 4).
John CATLING and Mary PAGE married on 13 Apr 1802,
in South Elmham All Saints and St Nicholas (IGI).
Harriet's forename is spelled HARRIETTE in her 1859
marriage entry (GRO), and in the baptism entries for her
sons Frederick and George.

Harriet gave birth to natural sons
Frederick CATLING (1852) and
George CATLING (1857), who
were both baptised on 3 Jun 1860
at Southelmham St Cross (parish
registers fiche 4).

Benjamin's parents were Benjamin HURREN, born in Henham,
Suffolk, and his wife Mary EDWARDS, born in Mutford, Suffolk,
who were married in 1843.
In the 1870 marriage record of Benjamin (to Harriet MOORE)
in the GRO he is recorded as Benjamin HURRAN, but his birth
registration is in the name Benjamin HURREN which is the
spelling I have found for all other records for this family.

Edith's birth was registered as
Edith Maud H. BROWN, in
2nd qtr of 1876 Mutford r-d
(which includes Kirkley).
Frederick and Hannah were
married in 4th qtr of 1878.
In 1881, Edith is recorded as
Edith M. BROWN, 5,
dtr. of Frederick CATLING.

Sophia's birth was
registered as
Sophia Eliza E. CATLING.
She is recorded in the
1901 census
as Ethel CATLING.

Birth registration Frederick CATLING (1852 GRO).
Baptism Frederick CATLING (1860 Southelmham St Cross parish registers).
Marriage Frederick Charles CATLING (1878 GRO).

Frederick was recorded in 1861 as Frederick CATLING "son of wife before marriage",
and in 1871 as Frederick CATLING, son (of William MOORE). I cannot find any
records in which he used the surname MOORE (unlike his brother/half-brother George).

Frederick was double-entered in the 1901 census:

He appears at 177 Maxwell St, South Shields, Durham, with wife Hannah and children
(apart from Edith).

He also appears as Master of the vessel "Edward S/S", off Newburn, River Tyne,
Newcastle, with Mate, John PELLIS, and Engineer, John HUNTER.

George' birth was registered as George CATLING
in 2nd qtr 1857 in Wangford registration district.
George was recorded in 1861 as George CATLING
"son of wife before marriage", and in 1871
as George CATLING, son (of William MOORE).

In 1881, still with his parents, he is recorded as
George MOORE, age 21, son (of William MOORE).

He married Dinah PAGE (1887 Blything r-d 1st qtr)
in the name George CATLING.

In 1891 and 1901, he is George MOORE with wife
Dinah and son Benjamin (or Bennie)..

This person was recorded as Bennie MOORE,
age 6, in 1891, and Benjamin MOORE, age 15,
in 1901, born in Wrentham, Suffolk in both cases.

Since George and Dinah were not married until
first qtr 1887, I think Benjamin may have been
a natural child of Dinah and, therefore, have
started out as Benjamin PAGE.

I cannot locate a birth registration in the GRO
under PAGE, MOORE or CATLING.

Please let me know if you have information.

Sidney was with his grandparents Abraham and Sarah HUCKLESBURY
on census nights in 1891 and 1901. I originally missed him from this
family. I was informed about him by contact and relative Michael Aldred.

Dinah's parents were Samuel PAGE, born Sotterley, Brampton, Suffolk,
and his wife Sarah [LURKINS], born in Uggeshall, Suffolk, married in 1853.

Dinah's father, Samuel PAGE, and Hannah Elizabeth BROWN's mother,
Eliza [PAGE], were brother and sister (both children of Jeremiah PAGE),
so two CATLING brothers (or half-brothers) married two women who
were first cousins.

Birth registration Mary Ellen WRIGHT (1863 GRO).
Marriage registration Ellen Mary WRIGHT (1892 GRO).
Recorded as Ellen in censuses.

Her parents were William WRIGHT, mariner, born
Southwold, and his wife Elizabeth [PEDGRIFT],
dressmaker, born Westhall, Suffolk, married in 1860.

Ellen is thought to have given birth to natural daughter,
Ethel Elizabeth WRIGHT, in Southwold in 1880.
