In her marriage record of 1833 in Woodton registers,
Mary's surname is spelled CODLING. In the baptism
record of her son James (1846 Bedingham registers),
her maiden surname is given as QUADLING.

In the 1841 census for this family are children Robert LEGOOD (8)
and Eleanor LEGOOD (3). See 1841 census HO107-0779-3-8-11.
I think these are misreadings by a census worker for Pheobe and
Edward, who appear in baptism records and in later censuses. There
are no baptisms for Robert or Eleanor in Woodton or Bedingham
registers.

Elizabeth's parents were John CATCHPOLE and Mary [GOOSE] who
were married in Hempsall on 18 Dec 1835.

Prior to her marriage, Elizabeth had 2 natural children,
Charles Albert CATCHPOLE, registered 4th qtr 1866 Loddon r-d,
and Robert George CATCHPOLE, registered 1st qtr 1868 Loddon r-d as George CATCHPOLE,
and baptised Robert George CATCHPOLE in Bedingham, 31 May 1868.

In 1871, Elizabeth was "Companion to grandmother", in Bedingham
with Elizabeth CATCHPOLE, Head, age 93, and had with her sons
George, 4, and Charles, 3, both great grandsons (of Head).

In 1881, Elizabeth, now married to Abraham LEGOOD, has her
other natural son by her recorded as Robert Geo LEGOOD, age 13,
son of Abraham (Head). This may or may not indicate Abraham is
the father in this case. The fact that there was now another
son named Robert James LEGOOD, age 7, in the family, could
indicate otherwise. In any case, I have included both CATCHPOLE
boys in the chart, although I do not know who was the father of
either of them.
