My contact Stephen Lord has identified this person (who appears in 1841 as Susann LOYD) as Sarah Ann LOYD and has found a marriage for her in 1872 to William SAUNDERS in 1872 in Kensington, and has located the following children:

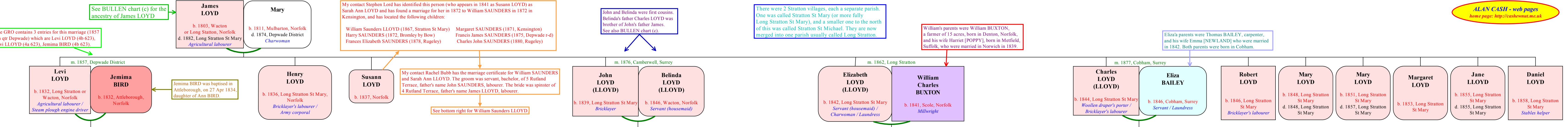
John and Belinda were first cousins. Belinda's father Charles LOYD was brother of John's father James. See also BULLEN chart (c).

There were 2 Stratton villages, each a separate parish. One was called Stratton St Mary (or more fully Long Stratton St Mary), and a smaller one to the north of this was called Stratton St Michael. They are now merged into one parish usually called Long Stratton.

William's parents were William BUXTON, a farmer of 15 acres, born in Denton, Norfolk, and his wife Harriet [POPPY], born in Metfield, Suffolk, who were married in Norwich in 1839.

Eliza's parents were Thomas BAILEY, carpenter, and his wife Emma [NEWLAND] who were married in 1842. Both parents were born in Cobham.

LORD LOYD LLOYD
The ancestral name for this family was LORD according to baptismal records for earlier generations. For some branches, the spelling changed during the nineteenth century to LOYD and then LLOYD.
On this chart I have used the surname spelling entered in the GRO birth record where found, followed by the GRO marriage spelling (in brackets) where that is different.

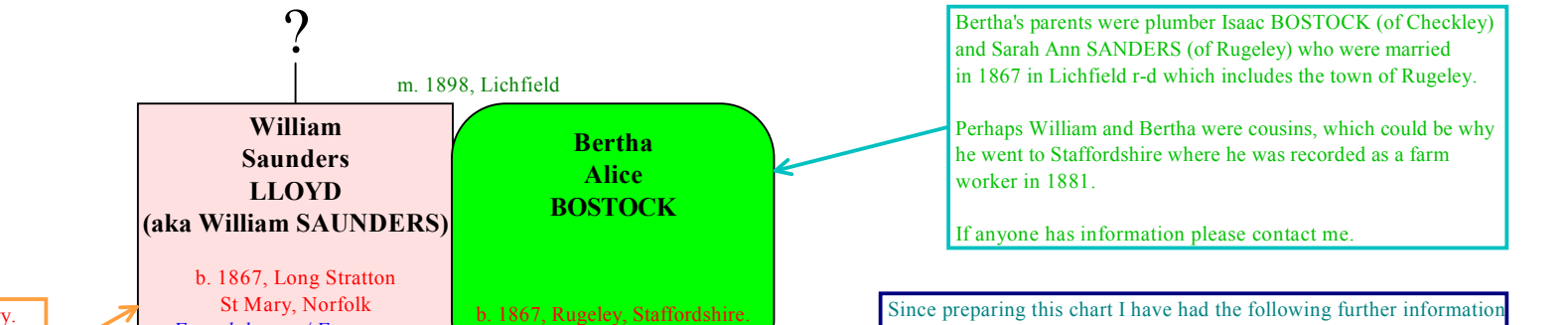
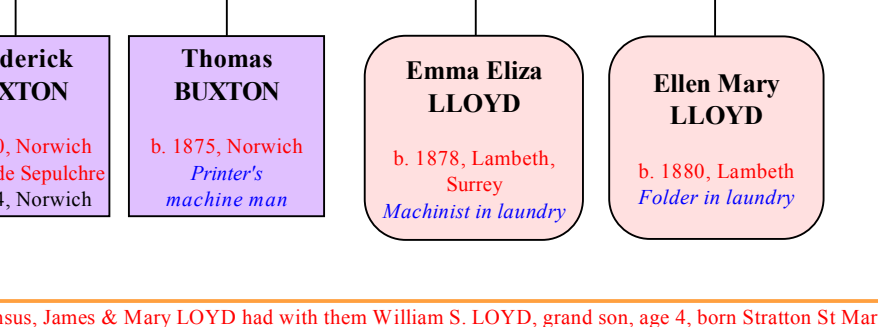
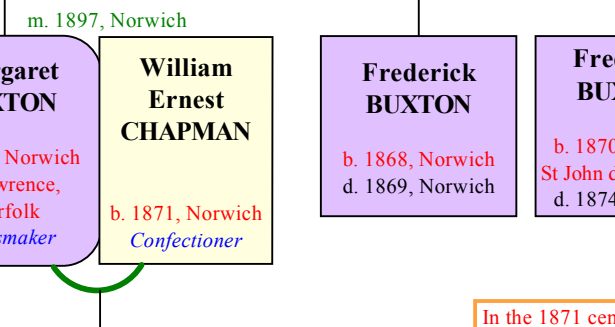
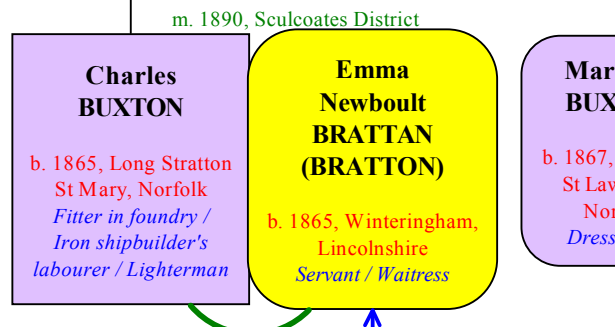
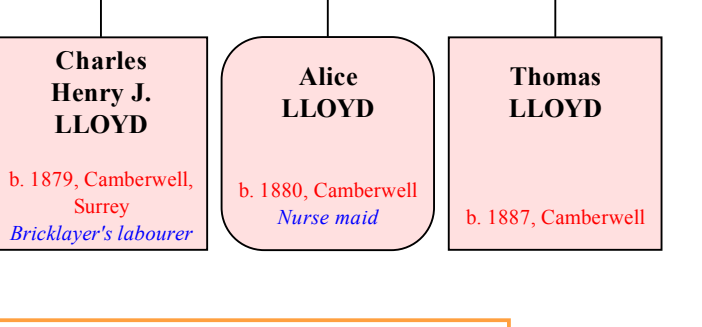
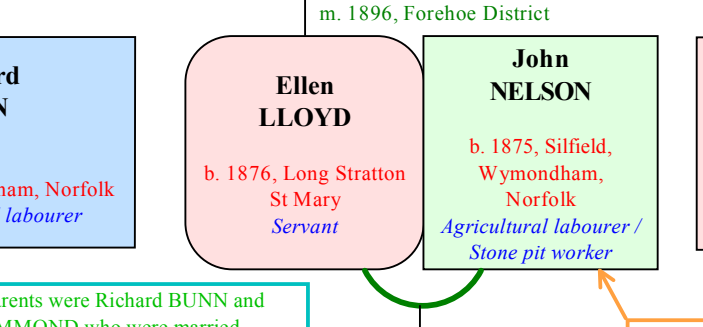
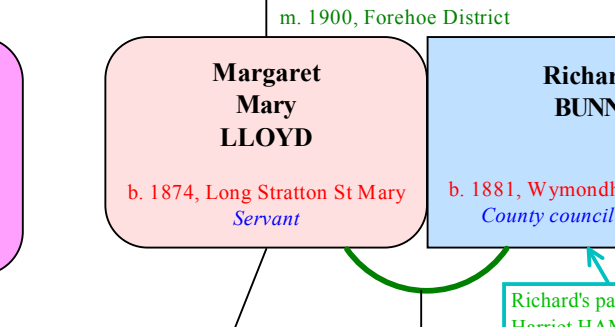
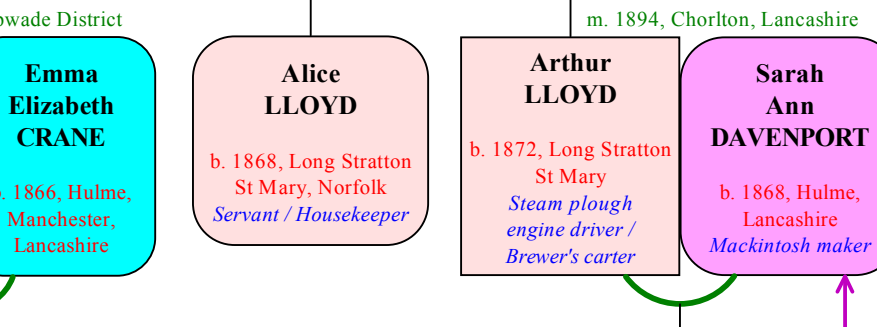
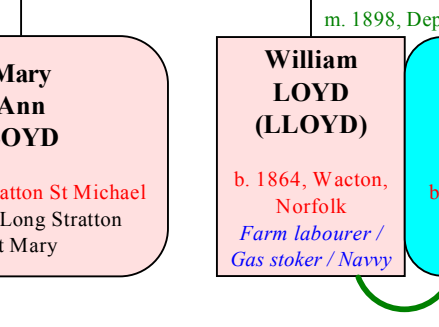
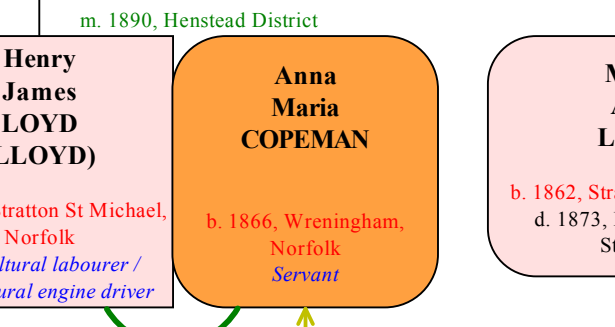
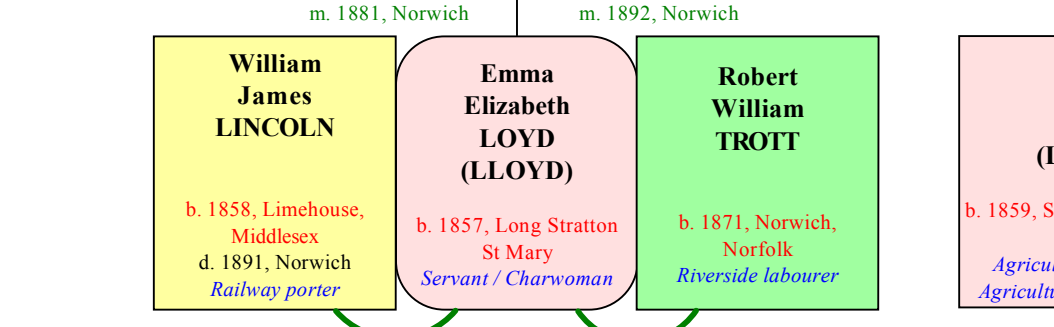


The GRO contains 3 entries for this marriage (1857 4th qtr Depwade) which are Levi LOYD (4b 623), Levi LLOYD (4a 623), Jemima BIRD (4b 623).

Jemima BIRD was baptised in Attleborough, on 27 Apr 1834, daughter of Ann BIRD.

My contact Rachel Bubb has the marriage certificate for William SAUNDERS and Sarah Ann LLOYD. The groom was servant, bachelor, of 5 Rutland Terrace, father's name John SAUNDERS, labourer. The bride was spinster of 4 Rutland Terrace, father's name James LLOYD, labourer.

Anna's parents were Edward COPEMAN and his wife Sarah [BELL] whose marriage was registered in Henstead District in 1856 (the village of Wreningham is within Henstead r-d).

Richard's parents were Richard BUNN and Harriet HAMMOND who were married in 1874. This was possibly a second marriage for Harriet.

John's parents were George NELSON and Mary Ann [HARVEY] who were married in 1870. Both parents were born in Silfield.

Emma's birth was registered in the first quarter of 1865 in Glanford Brigg reg-district (which includes the village of Wreningham) as Emma Newboul BRATTAN.

She was baptised (IGI) on 26 Mar 1865 in Wreningham, Emma Newboul BRATTAN daughter of Joseph BRATTAN and his wife Charlotte [NEWBOLT]. Joseph was a shoemaker, born in Wreningham. Charlotte was born in South Ferriby, Lincolnshire.

In the 1871 census, James & Mary LOYD had with them William S. LOYD, grand son, age 4, born Stratton St Mary. I am identifying this person with William Saunders LLOYD whose birth was registered in 1st qtr 1867 in Depwade r-d. I have not found out which of James's children was his parent. I believe this person was married in 1898 in Lichfield District in the name William SAUNDERS to Bertha Alice BOSTOCK.

Since writing the above note I have been contacted again by Rachel Bubb who now has William's birth and marriage certificates. On the birth certificate, William's mother is Sarah Ann LLOYD - his father's name is not recorded. On William's marriage certificate, his father's name is recorded as William SAUNDERS, policeman.

My contact Stephen Lord has identified William's mother as third child of James and Mary LOYD (see above right).

Bertha's parents were plumber Isaac BOSTOCK (of Checkley) and Sarah Ann SANDERS (of Rugeley) who were married in 1867 in Lichfield r-d which includes the town of Rugeley.

Perhaps William and Bertha were cousins, which could be why he went to Staffordshire where he was recorded as a farm worker in 1881.
If anyone has information please contact me.

Since preparing this chart I have had the following further information from my contact and relative Rachel Bubb.

Alice SAUNDERS married Fred HELKS in 1922 in Wakefield district. Fred (born in Normanton) was son of Thomas HELKS born Casteford and his wife Elizabeth [BIRCH] born Normanton, who were married in 1873 in Pontefract.

Florence Amy SAUNDERS married Arthur COURTEN in 1927 in Wharfedale district. Arthur (born in Thurlby, Lincolnshire) was son of William COURTEN born Thorney, Cambridgeshire and his wife Jane [HODSON] born West Derby, Liverpool, who were married in Penwortham Parish Church, Lancashire in 1889.

William and Bertha SAUNDERS had four further children born after 1900. They are not shown on the chart.
