b. 1826, Woodton, Norfolk
d. 1884, Bergh Apton
Agricultural labourer / Parish Clerk (Bergh Apton)

Mary MOORE
b. 1826, Hempnall, Norfolk
Farmer

m. 1848, Loddon District

From census information, the most likely year of birth for Mary is 1826.
In the period 1823-1829 there were 4 people called Mary MOORE baptised in Hempnall:
1823 Jan 5 Mary Ann MOORE d. of Timothy (labour) & Mary (late MOORE).
1825 Sep 2 Mary Ann MOORE d. of Moses (laborer) & Elizabeth (late PLUM).
1825 Dec 12 Mary Anne MOORE illegitimate d. of Harriet (spinster).
1826 Sep 26 Mary MOORE d. of William (labourer) & Sarah (late SHILLING).
I should be interested if someone has seen Mary's 1848 marriage certificate.

There is a muddle in the GRO over Elizabeth's birth entry. She appears as Elizabeth LLOYD, but her name (plus 4 others with surname LLOYD) have got separated from all the other LLOYD entries, and included several pages later with the LOYD entries (between "LOY" and "LOYDELL"). I guess she should have been entered as LOYD but I would be interested to know what was on the original register entry.

John's marriage to Augusta was his second. He first married Caroline WARNES in Norwich in 1872. She died in 1893, age 40.
There were at least 4 children from this first marriage:
John David CLARKE (1876).
Caroline CLARKE (1879).
Hannah R. CLARK (about 1881).
Gertrude E. CLARKE (about 1883).

Middle name Emeline in birth registration (GRO), but Emmeline in baptism (IGI) and marriage (GRO).

Frederick's parents were Samuel CRASKE, a coachman born in Alby, Norfolk, and his wife Mary Anne born in Brooke, Norfolk.

LORD LOYD LLOYD
The ancestral name for this family was LORD according to baptismal records for earlier generations. For some branches, the spelling changed during the nineteenth century to LOYD and then LLOYD. On this chart I have used the surname spelling entered in the GRO birth record (or baptismal name for those earlier than 1837), followed by the GRO marriage spelling (in brackets) where that is different.

Mary's parents were John GREENACRE, born in Plumstead, Norfolk, and his wife Susannah [GIRDLESTONE], born in Morston, Norfolk, who were married in 1850.
Some years after Mary married Henry LOYD, her younger brother William GREENACRE married Henry's younger sister Hannah LOYD (see to the right on this chart).

Harriet is thought to be natural daughter of Sarah SCOTT of Felthorpe/Haveringland, Norfolk.

Hannah's older brother Henry LOYD was already married to William's older sister Mary Jane GREENACRE. See the note attached to Mary Jane's box (to the left on this chart).
